

CMMI Appraisal - Appraisal Disclosure Statement Submission Policy

Purpose

This policy defines the requirements for authorizing an Appraisal Disclosure Statement (ADS) which is required pursuant to the CMMI Method Definition Document (MDD).

Scope and Applicability

All Certified CMMI Lead Appraisers (LAs) and Appraisal Sponsors are subject to the requirements of this policy. CMMI Partners are responsible for maintaining awareness of all LAs sponsored under their agreement and for their adherence to all CMMI policies.

Policy Implementation Detail

The ADS consists of three digital authorizations in the CMMI Appraisal System (CAS):

- **First**, the LA affirms that the information contained in the statement is accurate and that the appraisal was conducted in full accordance with the requirements of the appraisal method.
- **Second,** the Appraisal Sponsor affirms and acknowledges the appraisal scope, accuracy, validity period, and agreement to maintain appraisal records.
- **Third,** both the LA and Appraisal Sponsor have the option to provide authorization for whether ISACA is authorized to publish the appraisal to the Published Appraisal Results System (PARS) website, and whether ISACA is authorized to post appraisal accomplishments to its social media channels.

Appraisals will not be removed from PARS once published unless ISACA does so for quality reasons.
