What Has Changed?

Retirement of the Supplier Source Selection Practice Area but incorporates some of its content into **Supplier Agreement Management.** The Practice Area Enabling Virtual Solution Delivery is now called **Enabling Virtual Work** to highlight flexible work teams.

The Supplier Management domain is now **Suppliers**.
