



CMMI® Appraisal - Appraisal Team Member (ATM) Eligibility Policy

Purpose

This document records the eligibility requirements for individuals to participate as Appraisal Team Members (ATMs) on CMMI appraisals.

Scope and Applicability

This policy applies to all individuals seeking to participate as an ATM on a CMMI appraisal.

Background

This policy is an update to the CMMI V2.0 Appraisal Team Member (ATM) Eligibility Policy, policy number 2018-04.

Policy Implementation Detail

There are two pathways for ATMs to become eligible to serve on an appraisal:

1. The following pathway allows an ATM to participate on an appraisal which includes any domain (Data, Development (DEV), People (PPL), Safety (SAF), Security (SEC), Services (SVC), Suppliers (SPM), Virtual (VRT)):
 - Successfully complete the Building Organizational Capability course
 - Pass the CMMI Practitioner Exam
 - Possess and maintain the CMMI Practitioner certification
2. The following pathway allows an ATM to participate on an appraisal which covers any domain or which includes **only** the Development (DEV) and/or Services (SVC) domains in the appraisal scope (officially sunset on 30 June 2026):
 - Successfully completed the Foundations of Capability or CMMI V2.0 Upgrade Training course (officially sunset as of 31 December 2022)
 - Successfully completed the Building Excellence course(s) for all assigned model views, e.g., ATMs serving on Development appraisals must have completed Building Development Excellence; ATMs serving on multiple domain appraisal of Development and Services appraisals must have completed both Building Development Excellence and Building Service Excellence
 - **For former CMMI V1.3 ATMs**, an acceptable alternative is successful completion of the Introduction to CMMI V1.3 course in the relevant domain, e.g., Introduction to

CMMI-DEV, Introduction to CMMI-SVC, or Introduction to CMMI-DEV with Acquisition Supplement if CMMI V2.0 Upgrade Training was completed. Otherwise, the individual must have completed the requisite Building Excellence course(s)

- If participating on a multiple domain CMMI Appraisal, ATMs must have met the above criteria and all applicable Building Excellence courses (or appropriate upgrade course) for all assigned model domains
- Passed the CMMI Associate Exam
- Possess and maintain the CMMI Associate certification

Additional requirements and considerations:

- If participating on a CMMI High Maturity appraisal, ATMs must also successfully complete the High Maturity Concepts course
- In addition to the above eligibility requirements, prospective ATMs must meet all ATM requirements defined in the CMMI Appraisal Method Definition Document (MDD), including completion of CMMI ATM training, and be officially accepted by the Appraisal Team Leader
- ATMs must be individuals in good standing, having no current unresolved quality issues. Individuals whose certifications have been revoked for quality concerns are ineligible to be ATMs.
